If all the coalition partners/parties present unconditional consent to each government decision from its official platform and on media/madiak and notify on public domain

Yes=100 ; No=(-)150

If providing support to government, but not agreeing to government decision in parliament and from official platform, does DAU depreciate the rating of the party
Does DAU disqualify the party in coalition but not embracing the government decisions

Number of decisions coalition partners did not agree but remained in government.

(-)150 each decision

Coalition partners have given constitutional undertaking to own clearly/explicitly the government decision or not.
